



## Employee Has Close Contact with a Person Who Tests Positive for COVID-19

### Non-critical infrastructure employees

*Employees are not required to quarantine if they have been fully vaccinated against the disease within the last three months and show no symptoms.*

- If they are not fully vaccinated, or show symptoms**, ask the employee to go home immediately (or stay at home). They should quarantine for 14 days.
- Advise them to self-monitor for COVID-19 symptoms.
- Strongly encourage the employee to pursue COVID-19 testing, through Campus Health or their healthcare provider.

Instruct them to contact you immediately if they test positive for COVID-19.

### Critical infrastructure employees

*Employees are not required to quarantine if they have been fully vaccinated against the disease within the last three months and show no symptoms.*

- If they are not fully vaccinated, or show symptoms**, ask the employee to go home immediately (or stay at home) and remain at home until asked to come back to work. The employee may be asked to return for critical tasks if they are asymptomatic, use a face covering, and maintain physical distancing.
- Advise the employee to self-monitor for COVID-19 symptoms.
- Strongly encourage them to pursue COVID-19 testing through, Campus Health or their healthcare provider.
- Instruct them to contact you immediately if they test positive for COVID-19.
